Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) – The RCIA assists persons, age 7 and above, in a process of formation in the Catholic-Christian way of life. This is designed for persons who have never received Baptism, persons from other Christian religions who desire full communion in the Catholic Church, and persons baptized in the Catholic Church but have had no formal catechesis (training) in the faith.

First Reconciliation, First Communion, and Confirmation - The preparation for these sacraments is coordinated by the Director of Religious Education. Normally, we request the child has been part of a religious education program for a minimum of two consecutive years. Again, registration in the parish and participation by the family in the life of the church are presumed for these sacraments.

Marriage – Call the parish office to make an appointment with the priest prior to setting a date for the wedding. Our diocese offers very helpful preparation so please contact us at least 8 months before the proposed wedding date, if possible.

Pastoral Care of the Sick - Please call the parish office to request a visit to those who are sick and unable to attend Mass. The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick should be celebrated with the sick at the onset of a serious illness or before major surgery. Eucharistic Ministers are also available to bring the Holy Eucharist to the sick and homebound.

Adult Education and Formation – During the year several opportunities are offered for adults to learn more about the Catholic faith and practice of it. These are advertised in the Sunday bulletin.

Religious Education and Youth Ministry – Our parish offers religious education for children in grades K-8. We also have a very active Youth Ministry for grades 9-12 which includes religious education as well as social and service opportunities. For more information and class schedule please contact our Director of Religious Education.

Baptism – Parents who request the baptism of their infant children (those under the age of seven) must attend a Baptism Preparation Seminar. (Consult the bulletin for more details). Infant baptisms are generally within the Sunday Mass (except dur-
