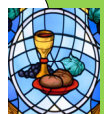

You are reminded of the Church's laws for fast and abstinence during Lent, which began Ash Wednesday, March 6, 2019. **Ash Wednesday and Good Friday** are days of **fasting**. Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are permitted one full meal and two lesser meals per day (which together should not equal one full meal), with no eating between meals. **Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent** are days of **abstinence**. Catholics who are 14 years or older should abstain from meat entirely. Soups and gravies made from meat are permitted. **Each Friday during**

Lent, the MHR Soup Kitchen Volunteers will serve soup from 6-7 pm. These meatless meals are designed for us to come together to support one another with our Lenten fasting. Stations of the Cross will follow at 7 pm in church. **(No Soup): March 29th everyone is encouraged to attend the Stations of the Cross at the Eucharistic Congress.**
