From the Pastor



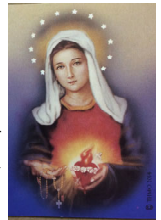
On First Fridays of each month, we will have the Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and Holy Hour for reparation for the intention of the expiation of the sins of others and against blasphemy and the sufferings of Jesus Christ. According to Sister Margaret Mary Alacoque, if you attend the First Friday Mass for nine consecutive months and receive Jesus in Communion in a State of Grace, you will receive the twelve promises of Jesus.

Also, on the First Friday of each month, for those who are homebound and can NOT attend Mass here at the Church, I will visit the sick in their homes at eleven o'clock after the Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. Please notify the office of those who need a home visit and provide us with their contact information as well as their address.

In addition, we will establish a Nine o'clock Mass on the First Saturday of the Month for reparation to the Virgin Mary with the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament.

For Couples celebrating wedding anniversaries— Every Second Weekend of each month, we will have a special blessing for those celebrating wedding anniversaries beginning with the First Year. Again, please let us know when you are celebrating your wedding anniversary so we can honor your commitment to each other during the Holy Mass. Also, for those couples who are celebrating their Tenth, or their Fifteenth, Twentieth.... Year Anniversaries, please let us know so we can honor you with the Renewal of the Marriage Vows.

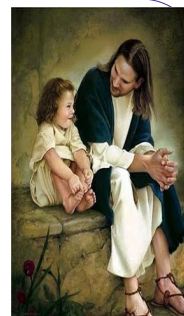
